the preparitive Meeting informs this that Elisha Hammer Requests a Certifycate to Lost Creek Monthly Meeting William Durham & Thomas Jones are appointed to Enquire into his Conduct and if they find nothing to hinder prepare one and produce to Next Meeting

There was an Epistle from our last yearly Meeting Received & Read in this Meeting the advices Containd therein were Satisfactory

There was three London Epistles Received at this Meeting Dated the 27th 4 Mo 1808 and one of them Read and the Salutary advises therein Contained were Satisfactory

At Our Monthly Meeting of Newbury held 3rd 2nd Mo. 1810 the representatives being called were present.

The queries were read in this meeting and answered in writing from the preparative meeting the Clerk is directed to forward them to the Quarterly Meeting

The friends appointed last meeting to prepare a certificate for John Maxwell produced one which was read approved and signed.

Our Friend William Williams in a solemn manner opened a concern in this meeting that had weightily impressed his mind for a considerable time to make a visit to friends and others as truth may open the way to some of the Eastern and Northern States, and after a time of Solid deliberation thereon this Meeting unites with him in his concern, William Durham & Evan Jones are appointed to prepare a Certificate for that purpose and produce to next meeting; Also to enquire into the friends circumstance and report their care to next meeting.
