

PROPERTY OF MEETINGS IN WILMINGTON YEARLY MEETING

Some Notes on Nomenclature:

"Established" refers to the date on which a superior meeting approved or authorized the subject meeting. It does not refer to the first session of the meeting unless no other information is available. Similarly, "laid down" refers to the date of action by a superior meeting and not to the closing session. More detail may be available at my Web site, www.quakermeetings.com

Meetings in the Northwest Territory established during the period from 1801 to 1812 were all subordinate to Baltimore Yearly Meeting and those from 1813 to 1821 to Ohio Yearly Meeting. Except to clarify title to property, this list includes no separate reference to those parent yearly meetings. A meeting established prior to 1821 is shown as subordinate to the yearly meeting to which its parent monthly or quarterly meeting was eventually attached.

"Wilmington Yearly Meeting" includes meetings that were part of Miami, Center or Fairfield Quarterly Meetings of Indiana Yearly Meeting (Orthodox) during the period from 1821 to 1892, unless the meeting was before 1892 set off as part of a new quarterly meeting, such as Eastern. A meeting that was part of one of these quarterly meetings in Indiana Yearly Meeting prior to 1828 is listed here as subordinate to Wilmington Yearly Meeting if the members affiliated with the Orthodox branch after the Separation. In Tennessee, the term includes all meetings under Lost Creek or Friendsville Quarterly Meetings even before Friendsville QM was transferred to Wilmington YM in 1897.

Miami and Center Quarterly Meetings of Wilmington Yearly Meeting united on August 8, 1969 as Miami-Center Quarterly Meeting. Except to clarify title to property, this list includes no separate reference to Miami-Center except with regard to meetings that first affiliated after 1969/08/08.
