### Required Courses

Writing Intensive.....	3 semester hours
Quantitative.....	3 semester hours
Humanities.....	9 semester hours
Social Sciences.....	9 semester hours
Science.....	8 semester hours
Fine Arts.....	6 semester hours

The major must include at least six semester hours of international knowledge courses as part of the above requirements. A complete description of Wilmington College courses that fulfill the quantitative, humanities, social sciences, science, international knowledge and fine arts requirements maybe found in the catalog.

**Note:** In addition to the required courses in the major listed above, students are also required to fulfill the Wilmington College General Education Program. The completion of 124 semester hours of academic work (including transfer work) is required for graduation and at least 40 semester hours must be in upper division courses. A minimum of 30 semester hours are needed to satisfy the degree residency requirement.
